Trainer or leader:	We're here to talk about budgets, but before we start, let's take a look at what's happening in <i>this</i> family.	
Parent:	(This person is sitting down, working on a budget, with a pile of receipts nearby.)	
Teenager:	(Teenager enters.) Hey, what are you doing? Homework?	
Parent:	I'm working on our weekly budget.	
Teenager:	Yuck. Looks like homework to me.

But if you really want to manage your money well—instead of having the money manage you—then you'll want to learn how to start a budget, keep a budget, and work on a budget on a regular basis.
