- 2. When one parent volunteers, a young person is three times as likely to volunteer on a regular basis than a young person who has no family members who volunteer.





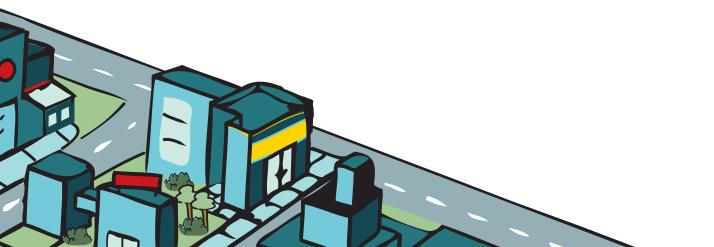
