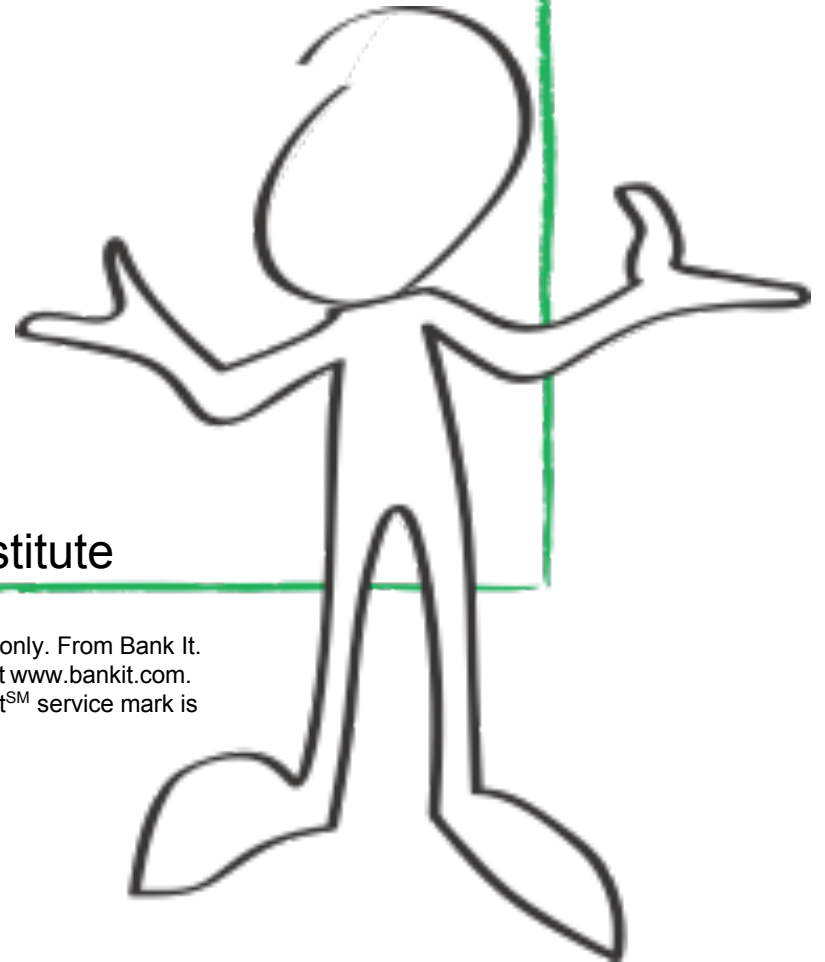

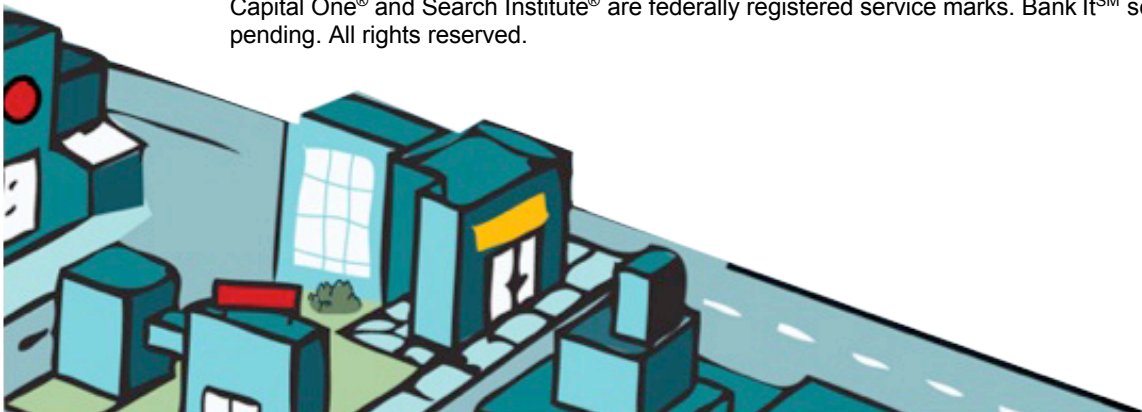

3. Someone begs us for something.

How can giving become part of a budget?

Giving can be a category, just like housing. You set aside money to give each time money comes in.

How can you calculate how much to give?

- Start small.
- Americans give an average of between 2 percent and 5 percent.
